### Entry Information

- Entries can be made at: [myesm.ca](http://myesm.ca). Set up an ESM account for you and your horse before making an entry.
- Entry fees due by closing date, payable by e-transfer to: [b.westar@gmail.com](mailto:b.westar@gmail.com). Late entries add \$20.
- Closing date: 8:00 pm, 5 days before each show i.e. Monday, 8:00 pm for Saturday show. Entries may close early if show reaches capacity.
- If entering more than one rider on a horse in the same division, please set up unique horse names in ESM  
ex: Sunkist 1 and Sunkist 2
- Scratch after closing but more than 48 hrs. before show start: \$45 (includes admin + hst).  
No refunds for scratches less than 48 hrs before show start. May substitute another horse/rider.
- Riders, owners and trainers must provide 2021 Ontario Equestrian (OE) membership number on entry form.

• **All inclusive price:** \$120 includes 1 Equitation/Hunter (E/H) division + in-ring warm-up, **or** 2 dressage tests, **and** admin. fee, medic, covid fee, and hst



**Add a second division for \$65** – includes warm-up and hst

**Add an extra dressage test for \$35** – includes hst

*Fee calculation (amounts rounded): E/H division + warm-up or 2 Dressage classes: \$57.50, admin: \$24.75, medic: \$13.25, covid fee: \$10.50, hst: \$14.50*

- Day stalls available: \$56.50 per day including hst, \$39.50 including hst for evening shows.

## Equitation/Hunter Divisions

- 3 Over Fences (OF) classes & no flat class (subject to change depending on Covid regulations).
- An in-ring warm-up is included before every group of 4 horses in each division.
- Divisions may be split (more than 12 entries) into Junior, Amateur and/or Open.
- Classes are judged as equitation unless otherwise specified.
- Horse/rider combinations may enter no more than 2 successive E/H or dressage divisions. They may cross-enter E/H and dressage classes.
- No oxers

Division	Specifications
X's (12")	Competitors may trot or canter any part of the course. Trotting is not penalized.
X to 18"	When cantering riders should attempt to be on the correct lead.
2'0"	2'0", 2'3", 2'6" - Skip or simple changes are not penalized.
2'3"	
2'6"	3rd class at 2'6" judged as Handy Hunter – Jr/Am/O

## Dressage Classes

- All tests to be ridden in 20 x 40 ring
- CADORA and Eventing dressage tests offered from Walk/Trot to Training Level
- Any non-EC Test of Choice that can be ridden in 20 x 40 ring.
- Classes may be divided into Jr/Am/Open depending on entries.

## Ribbons and Awards

- Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> in every class. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons and prizes in each division.
- Divisions may be split (E/H – more than 12 entries) into Junior, Amateur and/or Open.
- **Series High Point Awards presented at Finale Show (Sept 12)** to top 6 riders in each division. Must have competed at minimum of 4 shows with at least 3 of those in the division they wish to be eligible for awards. Riders are eligible for awards in up to 2 successive divisions.
- **TIP (Thoroughbred Incentive Program) Awards:** Special ribbon to Hi-point registered thoroughbred at the following shows: **June 19 • July 10 • August 14 • August 28 • September 12**  
Awards sponsored by the Jockey Club and Truly Thoroughbred. Be sure to register your TB with TIP before show day and include your TIP number on your entry.

## Covid Protocols

In place until further notice:

- All in attendance (competitors, coaches, guardians) must be pre-registered in order to enter grounds, including submissions of all applicable forms
- Masks must be worn by all while on grounds, except riders while mounted.
- Physical distancing must be practiced.

## The Show Day

As long as Provincial and local Covid guidelines are in place, your day will unfold as follows:

- Please only arrive at the show grounds with adequate time to prepare for your classes. You will be assigned a warm-up time before show day. You will be directed to your designated parking spot.
- Competitors in each division will be grouped in sets of 4 for warm-up and competition. We do our best to group competitors by trainer. Your group will have an assigned time to come the warm-up ring. You'll have approx. 20 mins. to warm-up on the flat (no jumps in warm-up area) before accessing the show ring for an approx. 10 min. group warm-up over the courses. We'll lower a few jumps as needed.
- After your classes please return to your parking zone and wait for announcement of results for your division before coming to the show office to pick up your ribbons/prizes.

## Tentative Schedule

- Depending on the show, there will be: 1) two Equitation/Hunter rings or  
2) one E/H and one dressage-E/H ring.
- All divisions will be available at 29 Again! Adult Evening shows, though some may be combined if entries warrant.
