

HUMAN & HORSE HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

COVID PROTOCOLS

These protocols are subject to change based on Public Health Guidelines in effect at the time of the scheduled competition

- Everyone who plans to attend the competition must fill out and submit ALL the required forms prior to arrival.

- Only riders and essential personnel permitted onsite to include: coach, groom, trailer driver, 1 parent for juniors. No spectators.
- Physical distancing is required.
- Screening will be performed at the show entrance including taking temperatures.
- Everyone must be wearing their mask while on site except for riders while mounted and while in your parking zone where you must still practice physical distancing.
- Wash hands often or use hand sanitizer
- Follow directional markers and remain within open access areas (see site map).

Classes/divisions:

- Classes will run in the posted order in groups of 4 horses, including open card warm-up if offered and selected. Groups will be organized by the show office and sorted by trainer.
- There will be 3 over fences classes per division. All trips will run concurrently within your group of 4 horses to provide a “show and go” experience.
- There will be no under saddle classes.
- Braiding will not be allowed.

HORSE HEALTH PROTOCOLS

In order to keep your horse and all horses on the show site as safe as possible please observe the following:

- **Proof of Vaccines:** Please upload an invoice or a letter from your veterinarian indicating the horse’s show name and date of administration of EHV 1 & 4 and Equine Influenza (as per Article A519). This can be **uploaded to your MyESM account through the horse’s profile**. Competitors failing to meet this requirement will not be permitted entry.

Equine Health & Contact Tracing Information: To be filled out by the trainer or owner of each horse coming to the show grounds to indicate that competing horses, to the best of their knowledge, have not been in contact with any other horses (away or at their home facility) exhibiting symptoms or signs of illness within the last 14 days.
- Record each competing horse’s temperature before heading to the show site and have the data available prior to access to the show site.
- All competitors and trainers must share knowledge of any sick or horse displaying symptoms of illness to show management immediately at info@westarfarms.ca.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- Try to arrive with enough time to prepare for your class but remember you will be remaining in your parking or stabling zone until it is time to come to the ring.
- Send only one person to pick up show numbers for your barn. Payment is due in advance. Please pay by e transfer to b.westar@gmail.com. Numbers will be available outside the show office. There is no indoor access to the show office. At the end of your show day, please deposit numbers into the bin provided outside the office.
- Warm-up and show times will be sent out to allow coaches to properly prepare their groups of students. You must be on time. Listen for the announcements as you may be able to start your flat warm-up earlier than scheduled.
- An announcement will be made when ribbons and prizes can be picked up outside the show office upon completion of each division.
