Closing date: Wednesday, July 28 at midnight.

Enter online @ www.competeeasy.com

Riders can download the **Compete Easy App** from the Apple Store or Google Play and see their scores and tests right on their phone as soon as the results are posted! Don't have a phone? No problem, we'll send the results to you by email.

New to Compete Easy? Go to www.competeeasy.com **-click- Equestrian, -click- Sign Up.** Enter your rider information (**My Account**).

To add your horse information, on left side of page **-click- My Horses** to add your horse information.

Now you are ready to enter the show! On the left side of the page **-click- Enter Events** and scroll down until you find our show.

Once you find Westar Farms Spring Dressage Show **-click-** Enter and now you are ready to choose your classes.

You'll be able to pay by credit card from the within the system or you can choose to do an e-transfer.

ENTRY RULES

Vaccinations: (A602) All horses attending Equestrian Canada sanctioned competitions must have met the requirements of Article A519, Vaccinations: see Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article A519, Vaccinations.

Not in Good Standing/Medical Suspension: Competitors on the [EC Not In Good Standing List](#) or the [EC Medical Suspension list](#) (Article 101 Section A, General Regulations) will be refused entries to the show.

NSF cheques will be assessed a \$50 surcharge.

Cancelled entries: You can cancel or modify your entry prior to the close date at no extra charge. Entries cancelled after the closing date, but more than 7 days before the start of the show will be charged a \$60 cancellation and administration fee plus HST. If you withdraw your horse from competition once the show has commenced there will be no refund of entry fees.

Post entries: add \$30, no exceptions. All entries received by the secretary following the closing date will be deemed a post entry. If you substitute one horse for another in the same class, there will be no additional cost.

Maximum tests per day: Horses may compete in a maximum of 4 tests per day.

Para-Equestrian classes will be governed by EC Para rules (Section E Dressage Rulebook)

ESD Walk/Trot Riders are in their first or second year of showing in dressage classes and are not permitted to enter classes that require them to canter.

ESD Green Horses are in their first or second year of showing. Restricted to Juniors and amateurs.

Coggins Test: It is recommended that horses have a current (within six months) negative Coggins test.

Class changes: No class changes permitted within 48 hours of show start.

MEMBERSHIP RULES

EC Horse License (Silver/Gold): All Canadian entries are required to hold a valid EC horse license to compete, or if owned by a temporary sport license holder, a Temporary Horse Registration Form must be purchased at each competition entered. Foreign entries must sign an affidavit. (A602.4). These fees are non-refundable upon the completion of the competition.

Adult Amateur riders must have Amateur Status on their Equine Canada membership card.

All trainers/coaches/Persons Responsible must carry the memberships and sports license equivalent to the level of competition where they are training/coaching.

ESD entries: both owner and riders must be members in good standing with OE. Proof of membership must be included with entry documents.

SHOW DAY RULES

Judge's and Steward's decisions are final.

Program Changes: Westar Farms reserves the right to make changes to classes, change the order of classes, to cancel, reschedule, or combine any division they may deem advisable.

Westar Farms and all its volunteers, Officials and employees will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury incurred to person, animal, or personal property while on the show grounds.

All **protests** must be submitted in writing to the show secretary within 48 hours of the completion of the class concerned. A \$100.00 cash deposit must accompany the protest and will be forfeited if the protest is not sustained. (EC A1204).

Show number pick up available outside the show office. There is no indoor access to the show office. At the end of your show day, please deposit numbers into the bin provided outside the office.

Competition number: must be worn at all times on the show grounds.

Headgear: All athletes, regardless of age or level of competition must wear properly filled and fastened approved protective head gear at all times when mounted at any EC-sanctioned Dressage competition at the event location (E.4.0.)

Medication control testing: Any horse entered in any Gold or Silver class at a competition may, while on the competition grounds, be selected for Equestrian Canada medication control testing.

Report to the steward: All Gold or Silver riders must report to the steward immediately following their test for a tack check. Failing to report will result in elimination from that class. In the event of Random Tack checks it is the responsibility of the rider to check with the steward if they had been selected. For full information on Tack Checks see Dressage E. 4. 16

Tack for ESD classes: to be in accordance with EC rules. Horses may wear boot/bandages; whips may be carried.

Lunging: permissible only in assigned areas.

STABLING

Day Stalls: \$65

A limited number of ringside stalls will be available. Stall can be booked in sets 2, 4 or 6 (or more) to maintain horses with others from their own barn and separated from those from other barns. Stall reservations are non-refundable after the closing date. Hay and bedding are not included in the price of the stall but can be purchased in advance.

SCORING, RIBBONS & PRIZES

- All **scores and placings** will be posted to the Compete Easy app (www.competeeasy.com/scoreboard/results).
- **Ribbons** awarded to 4th place. Classes will be split for awards (Junior, Amateur and Open) if sufficient entries.
- Where there is only 1 rider, percentages will be applied: 1st ~ 60% +, 2nd ~ 57 - 59.9, 3rd ~ 54 - 56.9, 4th ~ 51 - 53.9
- In classes with only an Open section with 6 or more entries (Gold, Silver or ESD), if there are 3 or more Juniors, they will be judged separately. If there are 3 or more Adults, they will be judged separately.
- An Open **Champion and Reserve Champion** will be awarded per level provided there are 3 or more riders at that level.
- In levels where classes are divided into Jr, AA, Open, provided there are 3 or more entries in each section, additional Champion and Reserve may be offered.
- An announcement will be made when **ribbons and awards** are available for pick-up outside the show office.

GENERAL GOLD & SILVER RULES & REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of “EC Rules”, will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book. All questions not covered by these rules shall be decided by the show management, whose decision will be final.

(A602.7) Per Article A801, every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC-sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Do not participate in this EC-sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition. Show management reserves the right to refuse entries based on EC rules. EC’s concussion-related **Accidents & Return-to-Play Rule** came into effect Jan. 1, 2017 for all EC sanctioned competitions in Canada. The full rule can be found in the **EC Rules, Section A, General Regulations, Article 101**.

(A602.1) The Westar Farms Spring Dressage competition is sanctioned as a Silver competition member of Equestrian Canada 11 Hines Rd., Suite 201 Ottawa, ON K2K 2X1 and is governed by the rules of EC.

(A602.3 (f)) The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

(A602) All horses attending Equestrian Canada sanctioned competitions must have met the requirements of Article A519, Vaccinations: see Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article A519, Vaccinations.

The show committee reserves the right to govern all conditions of the show. Questions not covered by these rules shall be decided by the show committee and steward and their decisions will be final. The show committee further reserves the right to cancel or change any class and to limit entries.

EQUESTRIAN CANADA STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE

ALL PERSONS SHALL BE COMMITTED TO:

- Upholding the welfare of all horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that all Equestrians including owners, trainers and competitors. or their respective agents, use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their own horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Providing current information on Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines and other equine health and welfare initiatives.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization’s rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions
- Actively promoting the development and adherence of competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horse.

HUMAN & HORSE HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Please complete the necessary online forms – EPL, waiver, covid prior to arrival on site. Form links will be available 48 hrs before show day.

COVID PROTOCOLS

These protocols are subject to change based on Public Health Guidelines in effect at the time of the scheduled competition

- Entries will be limited to meet federal/provincial/regional guidelines.
- Everyone planning to attend the competition must fill out and submit ALL the required forms prior to arrival. Only those with have forms submitted will be permitted onsite.
- Only riders and essential personnel permitted onsite to include: coach, groom, 2 parents for juniors. Physical distancing at the ring is required. No spectators.
- Screening will be performed at the show entrance.
- You will be directed to your designated parking area after being checked in.
- Everyone must be wearing their mask while on site except for riders while mounted and while in your parking zone where you must still practice physical distancing.
- Wash hands often or use hand sanitizer.
- Follow the directional arrows and remain in authorized areas as indicated on the **SITE MAP**.
- Schooling areas permit 8 horses and 1 ground person/horse only.

HORSE HEALTH PROTOCOLS

In order to keep your horse and all horses on the show site as safe as possible please observe the following:

Proof of Vaccines: Please upload an invoice or a letter from your veterinarian indicating the horse's show name and date of administration of EHV 1 & 4 and Equine Influenza (as per Article A519).

Equine Health Attestation & Contact Tracing Information: Each owner or trainer is required to complete an online Equine Health Attestation Form prior to arrival on site. This will indicate that competing horses to the best of the owner/trainer's knowledge have not been in contact with any other horses (away or at their home facility) exhibiting symptoms or signs of illness within the last 14 days. They also agree to **monitor their horse's temperature while on site**. Further, they agree to share knowledge of any sick or horse displaying symptoms of illness to show management immediately at info@westarfarms.ca.
